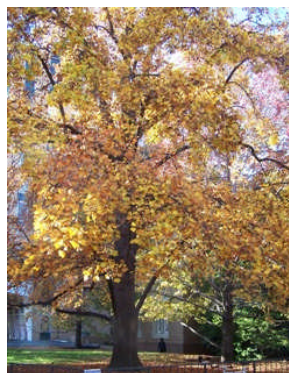
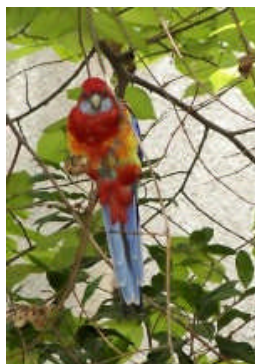
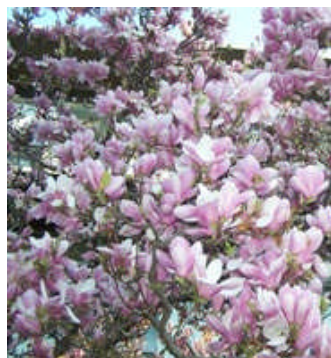


Walking in Parkville
